ADMISSION:

Applications must be submitted by **April 1, 2016**.

The following factors are significant in determining admission:

- ◆ Experience working with children and youth with disabilities (e.g., in a school, clinical, or home setting) or other experience with behavior analysis that is acceptable to the faculty
- ◆ Submission of Graduate Record Examination (GRE)
